**Costume Rental Costs:**

There is a 3% surcharge if rental is paid with a credit card.

To ensure the proper fit of the costumes rented, it is imperative that all measurements be sent to our costumer a minimum of five weeks prior to shipment (not production) date so that we may prepare your rental properly and ensure your receipt of same in a timely fashion. All dry cleaning done by TCO and included in the rental fee. All costumes can be returned as is after the last performance.

#### **Insurance:**

The Renting Company must supply Tri-Cities Opera with a Certificate of Insurance for:

#### **Costumes \$30,000.00**

In addition, the Renting Company must have proper Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, Workman's Compensation, and Employer's Liability Insurance and shall name TCO as "sole insured and beneficiary" for the rental period.

## **Transportation:**

Costumes will be shipped as the Renting Company arranges and pays for. If the costumes are rented together with the set, they may be transported with the set at no extra cost.

**TOSCA** Act I- Vari-colored chiffon gown, velvet spenser or shawl,

coordinating bonnet or veil

-OR-

Blue gown and jacket with matching bonnet (sizes 16 and larger will be in the  $2^{nd}$  outfit unless specified by renting

company)

Act II- Garnet velvet and white satin gown w/gold and seed pearl

embroidery, long white gloves, gold-trimmed black velvet

cape, matching jewelry parure

Act III- Same as Act I w/hooded cape (no bonnet or jacket)

**SCARPIA** Black frock coat and trousers, black/gold brocade vest, lace trimmed

shirt, black cape, shoe buckles

**CAVARADOSSI** Act I- Blue tailcoat, tan trousers, blue paisley vest, painter's

smock, lace trimmed shirt, white neckcloth

Act II, III- Tattered and blood-stained shirt and black sash, same tan

pants

**SACRISTAN** Brown cassock with smock, white alb

**SPOLETTA** Dark tailcoat, striped vest, tan pants, ruffled shirt w/neckcloth, cape

**SCIARRONE** Officer's uniform w/sash, cape

**ANGELOTTI** Tattered shirt, tattered smock, breeches, cape

**JAILOR** White shirt, brown vest, brown breeches

**NOTE:** No chorus or procession available for this plot.


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
